DRAINAGE ORDINANCE EXEMPTION

Family Express, Brookston

Surveyor Ward stated that the Family Express in Brookston is requesting an Exemption from the Drainage Ordinance. Darrell Edwards with Weigh Engineers spoke on behalf of Family Express. Mr. Edwards said that they’ve been in touch with the Town of Brookston’s Engineer, Ken Smith. The exemption they’re looking for is the requirement of detention, they’re going to use the existing residential drainage. The drainage from the site to the west will go into the storm sewer trying to minimize the water going to the east towards State Rd 18. Board Member Diener stated the Ordinance is clear and unless a valid reason can be provided, there will need to be a Drainage Plan for this project. There was a motion made by Board Member Diener made a motion that Family Express would need to submit a Drainage Plan in accordance with the White County Drainage and Sediment Control Ordinance, with a second from Vice President Heimlich. **Vote: Unanimous (3 – For, 0- Against)**
